GUIDELINE FOR SELECTION

Please read the guideline before fully registering to participate in the ICT 4 all Exhibition.

1. Theme of your project

“ICT”

The project must stem from concerns in the information or communication sector. ICT includes all electronic media, technology and facilities from radio to Information Technology programming solutions, from new hardware solutions to financing and initial support. Projects must relate directly to the 5 themes of the event.

“4 all”

The project must be useful for developing and/or developed countries or disadvantage groups or societies around the world. They have to contribute to the bridging of the digital divide between the South and North, poor and rich, women and men, young and old, etc.

2. Linking Geneva to Tunis

Preference is given to exhibitors from the ICT4D Platform, in order to show the progress of projects shown in 2003 and to provide a link from Geneva to Tunis. All other applications will be considered.

3. Status of your project

Projects in an advanced status of realisation or that are already realised are given preference to projects consisting of ideas and plans.

4. Diversity of projects

There is a balance to achieve regarding the distribution of continents and the diversity of the project themes. For the sake of this balance, some projects may be given preference.

5. Stand size

Individual stands:

- One project per 20m² of stand space. If exhibitors present more projects, project diversity can be criteria for selection.
- Per company max. 100 m² with at least 5 projects (only sponsors are allowed to have larger stands)

Pavilion:

- Minimum of one project per 20 m²
